1. PROSPECTIVE STUDENTS

Students may find all necessary information in our Brochure and the application form. In addition, we would like to inform prospective students of the admission, registration process and visa procedures in order to make the whole process easier and faster for them. The information regarding all procedures is given below in point form.

3. VISA PROCEDURE

Once a student has completed the above stated (section 2), s/he may apply to the Turkish Embassy or Consulate in relevant country. Each country has its own procedure. Therefore, students must contact the nearest Turkish Embassy or Consulate for detailed information. Students should remember that they must always show the Embassy or Consulate their **Formal Acceptance Letter** and **University Payment Receipt**.

4. TRAVELING ARRANGEMENTS

Once students have received a Turkish Transit Visa they are then ready to make their traveling arrangements. Students should inform us of their flight arrangements and the date of their arrival so we can pick students up at the airport during Orientation period (*there is an online Transportation Request Form that students need to fill out and send to the EUL in advance*). Students should remember that wherever they are coming from they will have a stop over in Turkey. ERCAN Airport of the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus will be their final arrival.

2. REGISTRATION PROCEDURE

Once a student has decided which program s/he would like to enroll in and has filled the application form, the student must send the **75 USD** application fee. This may be done in two different ways.

- I. Bank Transfer to our University account
- II. Send cash with the EUL application form and documents

Please note that the safest and most effective way would be making a bank transfer to our University's account (choice number I). When we receive a student's application and registration fees, we will send the student a "**conditional Acceptance Letter**" (*if admission is granted*) in contract format. With this letter, the student may send us *one-year tuition fee*, once again through bank transfer. When we receive this amount, we will send the student a **Formal Acceptance Letter & official receipt of payment**.

5. SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

There are various scholarship opportunities for International Students:

1. **40% Scholarship for all Int'l freshman students**
2. Scholarship for students who already have sisters or brothers at EUL (*50% fee scholarship*)
3. Academic scholarship for high-performing students.

1. 5% VAT will be added to all dormitory fees.

2. There are private dormitories and housing in the Lefke area available for students. Please contact the Accommodation Office for detailed information and reservation at 00 90 660 2000 ext. 2016 / 2018.

3. Students who join the EUL in the Spring Semester are NOT entitled to payment in installments. Thus, a student who joins the EUL in the Spring is required to pay half of the accommodation fee (\$1,000)

❖ CAMPUS I Male Dormitory

❖ CAMPUS III Male and Female Dormitory (separated)

➤ COST OF LIVING (Meals)

- Minimum \$ 4,000 per year
- Maximum \$ 6,000 per year

➤ BOOKS & STATIONARY EXPENSES

- Minimum \$ 400 per year
- Maximum \$ 700 per year

➤ STUDENT RESIDENT PERMIT

All international students are required to complete their Resident Permit procedures upon arrival. The International Office will assist students during this procedure. Students shall contact the International Office for more information on the **medical tests** required for the completion of the residence permit procedure.

Approximate expenses:

1. Hospital (Medical) fee (One time only): \$ 80 (approximately)
2. Resident Permit Fee : \$60 (approximately)

➤ ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS & NECESSARY DOCUMENTS

All international students are required to fill out the EUL Application Form that is available on the website. Once completed, prospective students should send the form along with the documents specified below:

- 1) High School Diploma for undergraduate studies and Bachelor Degree Diploma for postgraduate studies;
- 2) Transcripts of courses completed;
- 3) Copy of International passport;
- 4) \$75 application fee;
- 5) Financial Statement for International Students & Bank Statement;
- 6) English language qualifications such as TOEFL or IELTS. In case of students not holding such qualifications, they will be required to pass the EUL English Proficiency Examination (*the same applies to postgraduate students*)

➤ HEALTH INSURANCE

All international students are charged for Mandatory Student Health Insurance once they register at the European University of Lefke. The charge for the Health Insurance is \$60 per Academic Year and is renewed annually.
