

## **Higher Committee for Infectious Diseases revises decisions**

The latest revised measures and decisions adopted by the Higher Committee for Infectious Diseases came into force on Monday morning.

While no changes were introduced to the midnight-5 am curfew or the opening hours of supermarkets, restaurants, retail stores or other establishments, the maximum number of weekly charter flights for closed-circuit tourism was increased from eight to 11.

Passengers arriving from countries listed under the Grey category will be required to present a negative PCR test carried out in the last 72 hours upon entry.

These individuals will also be required to spend 14-days in a state monitored quarantine facility.

Starting as of this week, the higher committee has also introduced home quarantine for those who have come into contact with previously identified positive cases.

According to the criteria set by the committee, those who have come into contact with a person who has tested positive will be required to isolate at home for seven to ten days depending whether or not they have received both doses of a COVID-19 vaccine.

These individuals will be monitored via electronic wristbands.

Persons isolating at home will be required to separate themselves from other members of the household.

In the event the physical conditions at home do not permit this, the other members of the household will be required to seek alternative accommodation for the duration of the isolation period. If that too is not possible, the person who needs to isolate will be placed in a state-monitored facility.

The Higher Committee for Infectious Diseases has also decided to allow fully vaccinated tourists to cross over to the TRNC from South Cyprus for daily visits on the condition they present a negative PCR test carried out in the last 72 hours.
