

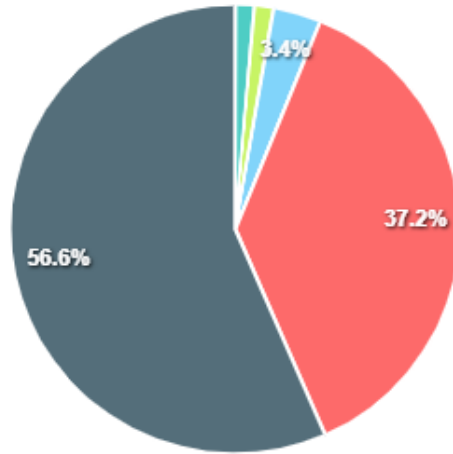

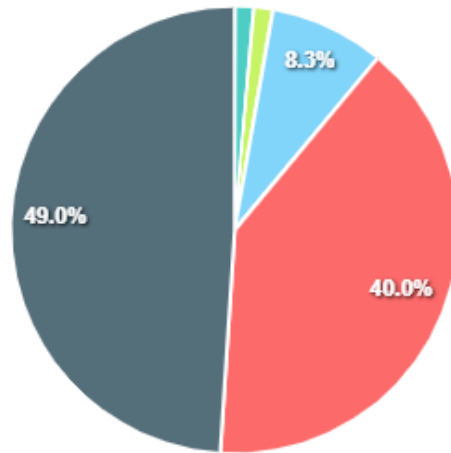

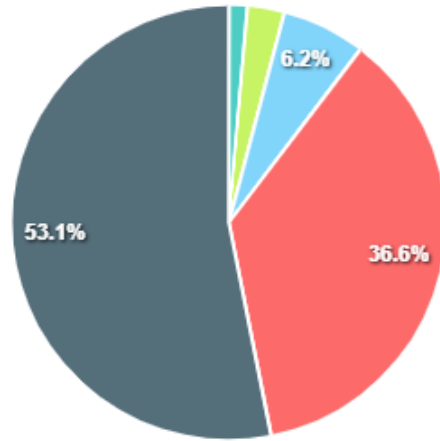
1. The course content clearly and accurately reflects the intended learning outcomes.



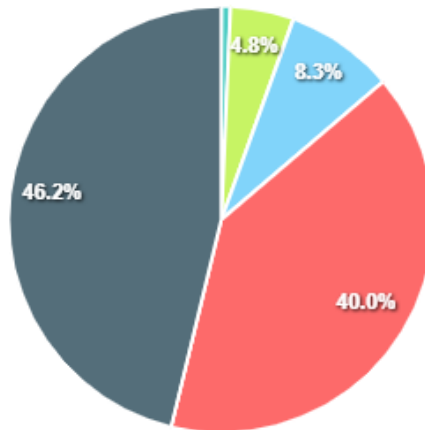
2. The course materials (books, presentations, videos, etc.) are sufficient to support the topics covered.



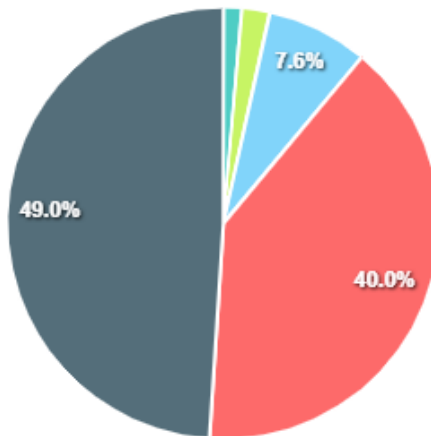
3. The course content contributes appropriately to the student's academic and professional development.



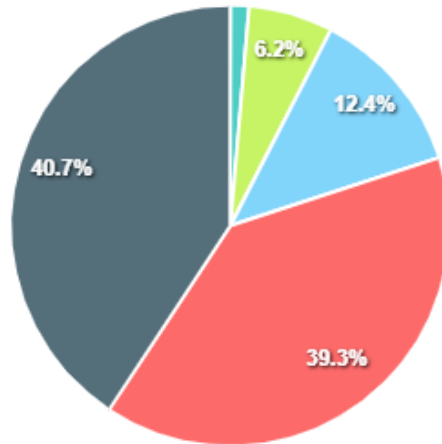
4. The scheduled class hours are sufficient to explore and discuss the topics in depth.



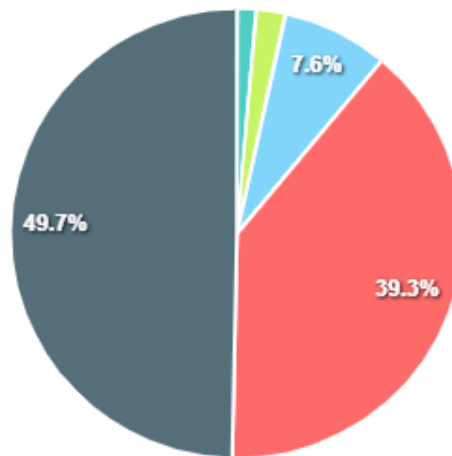

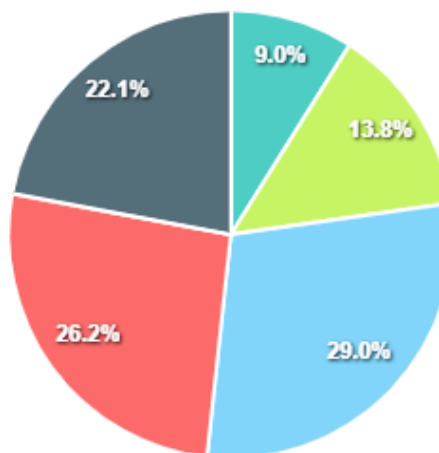

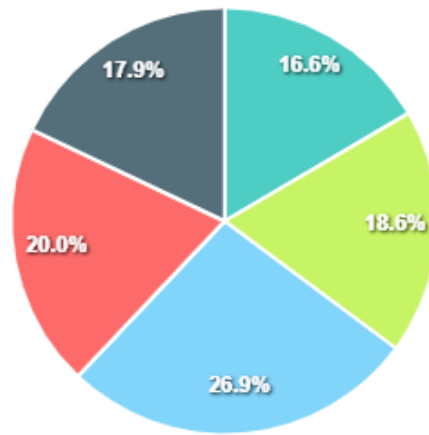

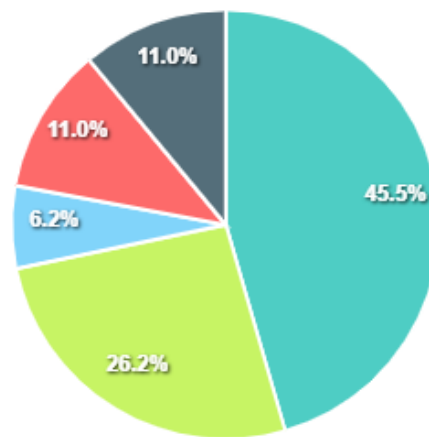

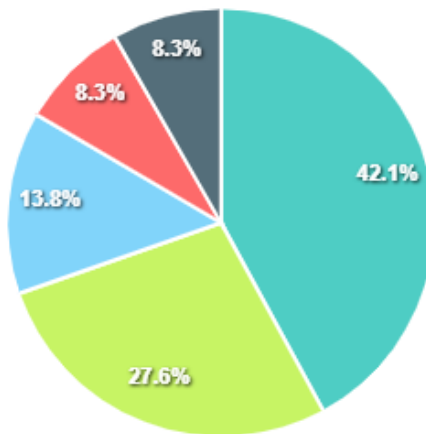
